Organization Details: The Bangor Area Recovery Network (BARN) is a peer-run and oriented recovery center, located in Brewer, Maine. BARN views recovery as a process of change through which an individual achieves improved health, wellness and quality of life. Recovery is a process of transformation in which we seek to overcome the harmful effects of a disease or debilitating condition and pursue a better life. The BARN works with the community to meet its goals. All are welcome.

Position Description: The BARN frequently holds special events like dances, holiday parties, fundraisers, and community outreach activities which require extra hands for set up, break down, and help throughout the duration of the event. Volunteering for special events is a great way to get involved with the BARN even if you cannot make a long-term or regular commitment.

Essential Duties and Responsibilities: Be flexible and willing to fill in where needed and as requested during the event. If you have any special skills that you think may benefit the event, please let the event coordinator know ahead of time. Specific responsibilities will vary by event, but most events will require help setting up, cleaning up, and maintaining the space during the event.

Training Requirements: Volunteers will be given instruction specific to their role at the event at the beginning of their volunteer shift. No prior training is required.

Length of Commitment: Volunteers commit to individual events and are only expected to participate in those that they sign up for.

Time Involvement: For the length of the event or a predetermined amount of time which will be specified upon sign-up.
